This week I'm guessing many of you like me will have caught yourself wishing the time to go by quicker until we can be out of Lockdown and back to our old lives.

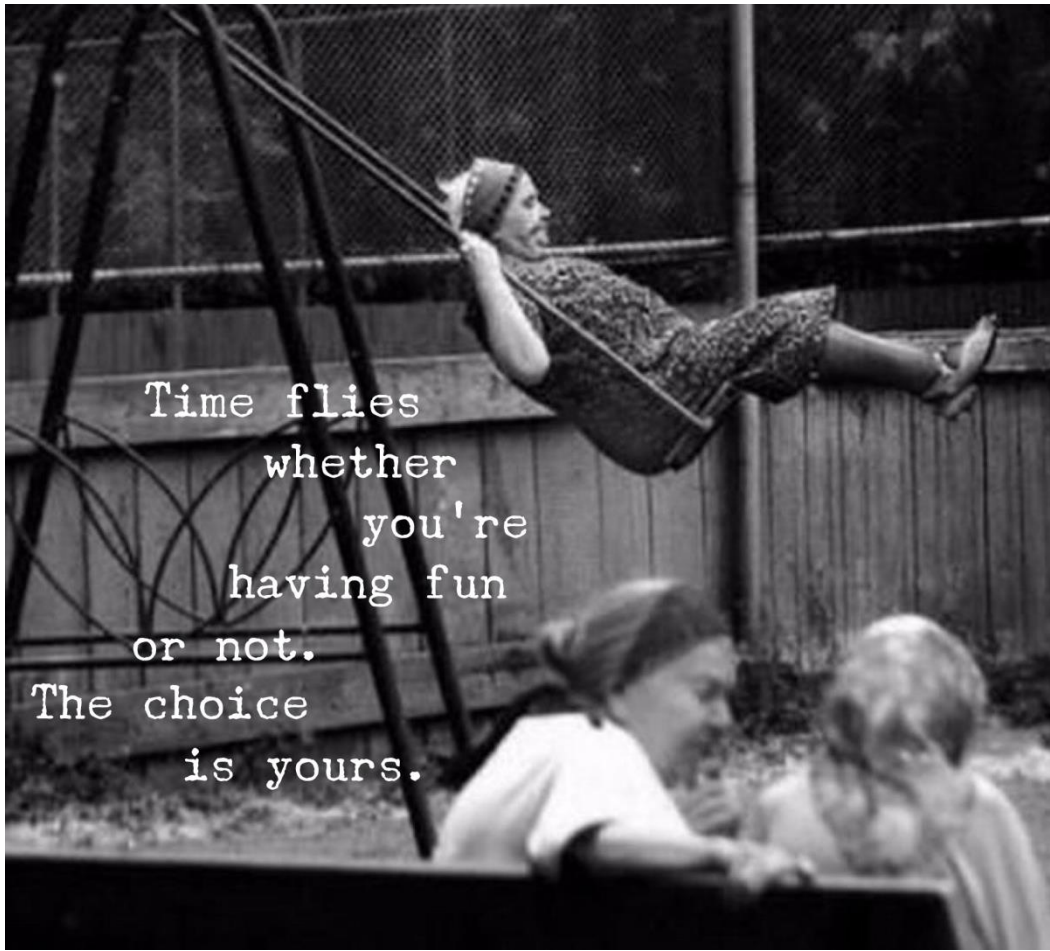
