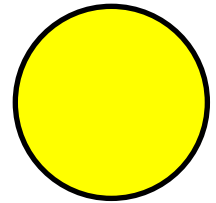


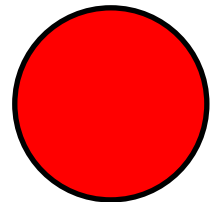
Traffic Lights

Traffic lights are a useful visual tool for supporting transitions.

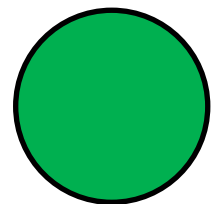
The yellow traffic light indicates 'one more minute'. It gives children a warning that an activity is coming to an end.



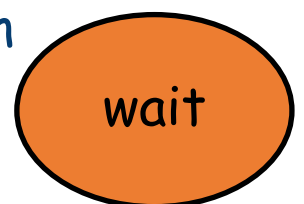
The red traffic light indicates that an activity has finished.



The green traffic light indicates that an activity is starting



The orange traffic light is to indicate that the child needs to 'wait' for an activity or object.



Traffic lights can also be useful when introducing turn-taking skills; e.g.

- "one more minute, then it's my turn"
 - "Waiting for your turn."
