

Chairs annual statement - review of 2017/2018

We have had a fantastic year, both financially and socially, striving to balance both halves of our constitution. This year has seen numerous new more social/activity events trialled, focused on building upon our school community relationships. These included discos, refreshments at the nativity, Christmas card project, pottery painting event, inflatable fun day and an end of year party. We also organised some very successful fundraising events with the Summer and Winter Fairs as well as another virtual balloon race.
