Before Choosing a Dream



Dreams Come True can only offer one dream per child. It is likely that once your child has had their dream, other wish-granting charities will be unable to offer another.



Good to Know:

Guidance for Equipment Dreams

Although we always try to get the item requested, Dreams Come True reserves the right to use an alternative supplier or provide an alternative item. Your child's Dream Coordinator will always check any items with you before ordering.

Before any items are purchased, please ensure:

- That both you and the child who is having the dream are happy with any items chosen, their quality and any adaptations.
- Items are safe and appropriate for your child to use and do not pose a risk to anyone else, consulting the child's doctor as required. Children should be supervised as appropriate when using equipment.
- Any items you choose are of a good standard and the company providing them has a good reputation.
- Items are well-maintained and treated as advised by the manufacturer
- The environment in which the child uses the equipment is free of anything that might pose a danger to them
- Items are checked to ensure that they are complete and undamaged when they arrive and the charity is notified quickly if there are any problems.

Dreams Come True is not responsible for ensuring that any adaptations or features of specialist equipment such as wheelchairs are suitable for the child. This is the responsibility of the equipment provider, any occupational therapist involved in the assessment process and the child's parent or guardian.

We are unable to fulfil dreams for:

- Pets
- Motor vehicles
- Hot tubs
- Any type of medical treatment or therapy
- Items that involve risk to personal safety
- Equipment that should be funded by the local authority or NHS
- Insurance, guarantees or warranties above what is included by the manufacturer
- Repairs or replacements if equipment purchased is damaged.

Good to Know:

Garden Equipment Dreams: Further Guidance

Dreams Come True will work with you to make your garden a special place for your child. This may include the following:

- Purchasing new garden play equipment
- Assembling and installing equipment
- Putting in plants or other items (e.g. wind chimes, mirrors) to provide a sensory experience for your child.

Dreams Come True is unable to help with:

- Ground works (e.g. excavation of soil or paving an area)
- Astro turf
- Hot tubs
- Building structures (although we may help with assembling equipment)
- Electrical works
- Plumbing
- Decking
- Removal of trees
- The garden makeover is a one-off experience, and once the dream has been delivered, Dreams Come True is not responsible for any upkeep or maintenance of the decoration, furniture or items provided. We do not provide warranties or insurance for any items (over and above anything provided by the manufacturer), repairs or replacements for any items
- You provide your child's Dreams Coordinator with the contact details for your landlord or Housing Association so that permission can be gained for any work taking place beforehand
- Both you and the child who is having the dream are happy with any items chosen & their quality before the charity purchases them
- You are happy with the person chosen to carry out any makeover and with the work that will take place in your home before this is booked in

- There is a safe route to the garden and that there is enough space in the access to the garden for equipment delivered and materials to fit through
- Any items purchased are safe and appropriate for your child to use and do not pose a risk to anyone else living in or visiting your household
- Items provided are mostly for the use of the child receiving the dream. Siblings and friends may wish to use the equipment too and this is fine but as a child only gets one dream, it is important to ensure that the dream mainly benefits them
- Any obstacles that might prevent the contractor from carrying out work have been removed before they arrive
- Someone is at home and ready to receive deliveries
- Items are checked to ensure that they are complete and undamaged when they arrive and to notify the charity ASAP if there are any problems
- Any children are supervised whilst work is going on and that they do not enter the workspace - power tools and other hazards may be present. If the contractor does not feel that it is safe to carry out the work, they will leave
- You share with us any concerns about any work or people carrying out work
- You notify us if anyone is unwell in the household or has been in contact with someone who is unwell
- You follow the covid guidelines outlined in our emails/letters to you which are in place to protect both you and the contractors visiting your home
- You choose items of e.g. furniture a good standard from reputable companies
- Wood is maintained and treated as advised by the manufacturer
- Any items you choose are of a good standard and the company providing them has a good reputation. Although we always try to get the item requested, Dreams Come True reserves the right to use an alternative supplier or provide an alternative item. Your child's Dream Coordinator will always check any items with you before ordering.
