



## **PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING & INVESTMENT**

Generally, 30% of the pupil population at Delamere are eligible for Pupil Premium funding, either through Free School Meals (FSM) or Looked After Children status. Pupils at Delamere in receipt of this additional funding make comparable progress in line with their peers.

There is evidence that the targeted interventions we provide at Delamere have a positive impact on progress.

Therefore, investment of this funding supports a range of interventions which are tailored to the individual, designed to improve pupil outcomes and are regularly evaluated. In addition, a small number of whole school projects focused on learning and quality of educational experience are facilitated through the financial support pupil premium provides.

This ensures all pupils that attract this funding benefit in many ways.

### **Funding for Pupil Premium to date has been:**

**2012/13 - £9,415**

**2013/14 - £13,600**

**2014/15 - £21,600**

**2015/16 – £21,700**

**2016/17 - £34,320**

During the years 2012-16 we have invested in updating our ICT resources, introducing an iPad project which included the purchase of iPad's, relevant hardware, software and training support. We have also invested in high quality Arts provision, funded a Parent Support Worker, introduced music intervention for LAC children and supported the Forest School Project to go from strength to strength.

However, our most important spending during 2016-17 has been the introduction of a highly specialist intervention teacher for one day a week.

### **Expected Spend for 2016/17:**

The expected outgoing spend for the current academic year will include:

- One on One Intervention Teaching
- Individual reading intervention
- Parent Support Advisor
- Music Provision – including therapy
- Forest School project
- Specialist Theatre Productions for ASD & PMLD
- Pet Therapy
