<p>In Science we are looking at animals. You could look at animal books and play with animal toys. You could talk about the animals name, what sound they make, and describe them . You could visit a farm or zoo as part of this.</p>	<p>We are looking at special people in R.E. Why not discuss who is in your family and look at photos that you have at home. As part of this please could you send in some photos of family, friends or other people who are special to your child.</p>	<p>In P.E. we are focussing on gymnastics – looking at different ways of moving. You could practice movement at home, or in the park. Can they run, jump, crawl, or roll?</p>
<p>We are still practising writing our name—this can be on paper, in mud, bubble bath or anything you have at home. If they can do this, you could have a look at writing simple sentences, e.g. the dog ran home. You could also look at trailing fingers through media to make marks.
