Issues discussed;

1. Matters Arising

2. Main Discussion Item

- **a) After School Clubs.** We currently run afterschool club on a Monday and Friday until 5:00pm but have a very low take up. We discussed possible reasons and ways to make it more accessible.
 - Thursday rather than Friday (not Tuesday as hideaway run a SEN session then)
 - End at 5:30pm (accept may be increase in cost)
 - Pay weekly (but commit to half term)
 - More information about what activities they do
 - Is a breakfast club possible?
 - Reassurance staff are trained to meet medical need.
 - A free taster session
 - See also attached questionnaire.

b) Life Skills for Little Ones.

LJ shared the document from Falkirk OT team. Firstly, we considered areas that would have been helpful to have information on prior to starting here.

- Toileting
- Eating / dietary
- Who to go to for help / support groups
- What is a special school?
- Challenging behaviour
- Sensory issues
- Wheelchairs where to get one and accessible places to go
- Communication basics, visuals, objects of reference
- Signposting
- Introduction state things take time

We agreed the document was long and that QR codes to sections on the website that were relevant would be more useful.

We then looked at the document in more detail, the way it was laid out, the subjects etc.

LJ will collate this information and bring back to the Parent Council in the future as the document develops.

During the conversation the idea of a drop in for parents was discussed. All agreed they would welcome a drop in, perhaps monthly to follow on from Delamere: Lets Get Started. LJ to take this forward.
