- 2. Main Discussion Item Becoming a Trauma Informed Attachment Aware School.
 - a) What does trauma and attachment mean to you?
 Trauma a negative physical or mental experience, large or small
 Change of routine, a change to something new. Takes time to adjust.
 - b) CJ gave a presentation about what it means to become a Trauma Informed Attachment Aware School. CJ recognised that it is a very emotive subject, we discussed important points for presenting to whole school community
 - > Be clear about why we are asking for detailed histories
 - > Highlight various support for parents
 - > Show empathy
 - c) Ideas on how to launch to Delamere families?
 - > 2 sessions during school time and outside of it
 - Film presentation (Not session as could contain personal discussions) and perhaps a parent's story
 - > Offer online session
 - Have a launch week where we highlight all the activities, we already do to support children and families
 - > Perhaps include a parent in the staff training
 - Discussion about when to ask about history, perhaps rather than meet the teacher it could be a slot and a chance for the parents to share the child's journey, as well as their own.
 - > Important to build a connection with the parent.
